Introduction and framework

HAH Lucknow two years of its successful running and serving to the children with cancer and their families. It was started in August'2019 in the partnership with Cankids...Kidscan,

The HAH is fully functional with all household facilities and is providing services to the children undergoing treatment in the KGMU hospital. Cankids...Kidscan is an implementing partner and providing financial support as well as treatment support services in the HAH.

Under the Project HAH we are providing following services and ensuring:

- To provide outstation families with affordable, child appropriate accommodation during treatment
- > To Integrate project HAH into the treatment, care and support systems at the Hospital
- > To improving the overall standards of treatment & care
- > To provide atmosphere like home
- > To focus on individual hygienic cooking facilities and common dining areas to cater to the children's individual taste, failing appetites and need for healthy nutrition, which is vital for the success of their treatment
- To focus on hygiene, proper storage of medicines, and information and support for proper follow up of Doctor's instructions
- ➤ To set up a school Room to ensure that children continue to receive education through Non-Formal Education Program
- > To provide emotional and Psychosocial support, outings, recreational and community activities.
- > To provide transport facility between hospital and HAH
- > To provide cooking facilities
- > To provide administrative assistance
- 1) Children are selected by treating doctors for stay in HAH and Doctors held responsibility HAH Coordinator to send the children to HAH once identified and finalized.
- Dr. S.P. Verma from Haematology Department of KGMU visited HAH and saw the facilities provided to the children and their families and now Haematology department also sending the children to the HAH.
- 3) Eshwar Child Welfare Foundation and Satya Sai Sewa Sansthan Organization every week & regularly providing ration to the HAH.
- 4) HAH Coordinator undertakes visits at HAH in weekly ensuring comfort stay of children and their families at HAH.
- 5) Patient Navigator and Care Taker & HAH Supervisor are available 24 hours in HAH for help to the families in every situation.



Precaution and necessary steps taken during Covid-19 Pandemic

We are well prepared for the prevention of a possible outbreak of the Covid-19 epidemic in the HAH. We are strictly following the guidelines provided time to time by Govt, Cankids & treating doctors. We are taking all necessary precaution to monitor & prevent the spread of Covid-19 in the HAH.

HAH is equipped with following instruments & items to fight with Covid19.

- A. Oxygen Concentrator
- B. Battery operated spray machine and disinfectant solution.
- C. Infrared Thermometer
- D. Oximeter
- E. Glucometer
- F. BP instrument
- G. Hand sanitizer
- H. PPE Kit
- I. Gloves
- J. Masks
- K. Floor disinfectant solution
- L. Ambulance on call in case of any emergency

At HAH premises, the following care is being followed

We are taking every precaution to prevent the potential spread of the virus. The following protocols have been implemented in HAH:

- 1. Hand sanitizer is available at entrance area and patients/caregivers are instructed to use it on their arrival and departure.
- 2. It is mandatory for patients/caregivers to use face masks whenever they go out or enter HAH.
- 3. As it has now been declared a global epidemic, we are taking temperature and checking oxygen level every day in the morning and evening of all patients/caregivers.
- 4. We recommend daily that patients and parents should avoid close contact with those who suffer from respiratory insufficiency.
- 5. On daily basis we ask them to wash hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after going to the bathroom, before eating and after blowing your nose, coughing or sneezing. Always wash hands with soap and water if hands are visibly dirty.
- 6. We also ask them to use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer provided to each family in HAH.
- 7. We recommend them avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth if they go out to hospital for treatment and it is advised that they should not join large crowds or gatherings.



- 8. Clean and disinfect frequently the touched objects and surfaces using a household cleaning spray or wipe.
- 9. We do disinfect E-Rikshaw daily before children and families board a Rikshaw.
- 10. We are screening all the patients/attendants before entering the HAH.
- 11. Now Covid-19 situation is normalize so we are allowed to Outsider / visitors for visit the HAH but not more than five persons & Cankids team are allowed to visit the HAH.
- 12. Daily reporting to Cankids in prescribed format given.

Month wise and cumulative status of patients and caregivers stayed in HAH

A month wise list of patients stayed in HAH is given below. HAH is almost running with full occupancy. In first half year from 1st April to 30th Dept 50 patients along with their 96 attendants stayed in HAH.

Weekly Sanitization of HAH Building

➤ Sanitization is a regular process in HAH. Every week we sanitization drive and do complete sanitization including rooms, kitchen, play room, washrooms, corridors, stairs etc. We ensuring that HAH should be safe for all children and their families. We are doing complete sanitization of HAH building every week by spray machine and disinfectant solution.





Play Room Activities & Diet Session by Dietitian cum Tutor

- New desktop computer has been purchased and installed in the play room that will help to provide basic computer education to the children and will help improve their skill.
- ➤ Weighting machine, High measurement tool and MUAC also provided in the play room in this quarter.
- ➤ Dietitian conducted awareness session with patients & families for maintaining hygiene to HAH families.
- > Children have been found much happier when playroom was opened for them.
- ➤ Children spent good time in playroom, learned basic education, played with toys and educational toys and various items.
- Tutor teaching basic education to all the children in playroom.
- ➤ Dietitian also conducted drawing & craft activity for the children & children also happily participating in such activities.











Routine services by dietitian

- A. Counselling on hygiene and sanitization in daily basis.
- B. Cleanliness check in Kitchen area as well as utensils.
- C. Sessions on nail cutting, hand washing, room cleanliness and self-hygiene practice for both patients and their parents.
- D. Nutritional Counselling and healthy dietary practices of patients (Diet chart provided by KGMU Hospital).
- E. Regular Follow-up with parents and patients in HAH for any query.
- F. Every week checked 24 hours of Dietary recall of patients (Chart filled by patient's attendants.)
- G. Monitoring patient's details like Height, weight, MUAC and Haemoglobin.
- H. Combine session for group counselling on other various issues.
