# **Introduction & framework**

Home Away from Home (HAH) Lucknow was inaugurated on 15<sup>th</sup> August' 2019, since than HAH has been continuously providing accommodation to the children & their families suffering from cancer along with holistic care & treatment support services such as medicine, investigation, education, counselling, transportation, financial support etc.

The HAH is fully functional with all household facilities & is providing services to the children undergoing treatment in the KGMU hospital. We are providing financial support, technical support, social support & treatment support services in the HAH.

Under the Project HAH we are providing following services & ensuring:

- > To provide outstation families with affordable, child appropriate accommodation during treatment
- > To Integrate project HAH into the treatment, care & support systems at the Hospital
- > To improving the overall standards of treatment & care
- > To provide atmosphere like home
- > To focus on individual hygienic cooking facilities & common dining areas to cater to the children's individual taste, failing appetites & need for healthy nutrition, which is vital for the success of their treatment
- > To focus on hygiene, proper storage of medicines, & information & support for proper follow up of Doctor's instructions
- ➤ To set up a school Room to ensure that children continue to receive education through Non-Formal Education Program
- ➤ To provide emotional & Psychosocial support, outings, recreational & community activities.
- ➤ To provide transport facility between hospital & HAH
- > To provide cooking facilities
- ➤ To provide administrative assistance
- 1) Children are selected by Dr. Nishant Verma for HAH stay & Dr. Nishant Verma held responsibility our Social Worker Sangeeta Sahu to send the children to HAH once identified & finalized.
- 2) Eshwar Child Welfare Foundation & Satya Sai Sewa Sansthan Organization every week & regularly providing ration to the HAH.
- 3) We are available 24 hours in HAH for help to the families in every situation.

#### Children and Caregivers stayed in HAH during the quarter

- ❖ July Month: Total 43 children with their 80 family members stayed in HAH.
- ❖ August Month: Total 43 children with their 81 family members stayed in HAH.
- ❖ September Month: Total 53 children with their 99 family members stayed in HAH.

#### **Weekly Sanitization of HAH Building**

➤ We are doing complete sanitization of HAH building every week by spray machine & disinfectant solution.





#### Play Room Activities & Diet Session by Dietitian cum Tutor

- ➤ Play room at ground floor is well equipped with desk top computer, toys, fun books, educational books, basic teaching material etc.
- ➤ Dietitian conducted awareness sessions with patients & families on hygiene on regular basis.
- ➤ Children spent good time in playroom, learned basic education, played with toys & educational toys & and do various learning craft activities.
- ➤ Children learn basic education in play way mood with fun & various teaching activities in the play room.
- Tutor also conducted drawing & craft activity for the children & children also happily participating in such activities.















#### **Routine services by Dietitian**

- A. Hygiene & sanitization on daily basis.
- B. Cleanliness checks in Kitchen area also to ensure that all utensils are kept clean.
- C. Nail cutting, hand washing, room cleanliness and self-hygiene practice for both patients and their parents is a daily routine.
- D. Awareness sessions conducted on hygiene maintain.
- E. Conduct sessions on importance of cleanliness of hands before and after food.
- F. Nutritional Counselling and healthy dietary practices for patients (Diet chart provided by KGMU Hospital).
- G. Regular Follow-up with caregivers & patients in HAH.
- H. To keep monitoring patient's details like Height, Weight, MUAC & Haemoglobin.

#### Beds increased to accommodate more children in the HAH

# Cancer Awareness Campaign and Monthly Birthday celebrated on 19<sup>th</sup> September 2023

- ❖ Monthly birthday celebration & Cancer Awareness Campaign organized together.
- ❖ All the children, their family members, visitors and staff members participated in the celebration. The activity area decorated with balloons & birthday symbols. Counsellor, dietitian and social worker talked about childhood cancer, early detection and early diagnose, care, bring the child to cancer care centre, maintain high level of hygiene etc.
- Childhood cancer is curable if diagnosed at early stage and proper treatment is provided to the child at cancer centre with love and care.
- Care givers shared their experience and cancer journey, the problem they faced and how they came out from the all-difficult situations.
- ❖ A discussion was held among the family members on how a healthy and nutritious diet is important in the treatment of a child is important.
- ❖ We also celebrated monthly birthday in the HAH in which all children participated. Children cut the cake. Gifts, toys, Cake, biscuit, namkeen, chips and fruity etc distributed to the children.





















# Cooking Competition held in HAH on 29th September 2023

- ❖ These children suffering from cancer require healthy and nutritious diet as suggested by dietitian / nutritionist time to time according. Healthy diet and nutrition help children in improving their health, increase their immunity and weight.
- ❖ In HAH all the family members prepare food for their children of their choice as suggested by doctors, dietitian/ nutritionist. We have organised a cooking competition in HAH in which all the attendants participated with enthusiasm under the supervision of dietitian and HAH care taker.
- ❖ All the participants prepared very delicious and nutritious food, tested by all and prices and gifts given to winners and all.



















#### **HAH Caretaker's Daily Routine work**

- Close monitoring & facilitate the comfort stay of families.
- ❖ She ensured that every child staying in the HAH should take all medicine on time.
- ❖ Counselled every new family before going in the room explained rules & regulations of HAH.
- ❖ Counselled all patients & caregivers regarding personal hygiene & room cleanliness.
- Provided welcome kit to the new family & received back, when family was discharged from HAH.
- ❖ Counselled all caregivers to keep the bathroom clean & flush after the use.
- Counselled about uses of induction cooktop, Kitchen & utensils cleanliness.
- \* Ration & Vegetables distribution. Nutrition distribution.
- ❖ Measuring temperature of all the children in the morning & evening.
- ❖ Actively Participated all the HAH events & activities.











## **Reintegration Programme – Beauty Parlor course**

Families come to town from far away, remote areas, villages, small towns and these families stay in town for treatment of children for a long time. These families' financial conditions are not well and belong to poor and BPL categories. Many time they do not have enough money to feed the child and themselves. We have started a Beauty Parlor course in HAH for such female attendants who have to stay for a long time. In this period, they get trained in Beauty Parlor Course and when they go back to their home town, they earn money and help the family. We provide all the participants stipend and after completion of course a Beauty Parlor Kit also.





## **Regular counselling by trained Counsellor**

The trained counselor comes twice in a week and does counselling the children, parents and group counselling also.
